“Two weeks ago I received a phone call from an importer telling me that the representative of Burgundian winery, Maison Champy, wanted to have lunch with me to showcase his wines. An Englishman (!) living in Beaune and representing a very old and traditional Burgundian house, talking with passion about Burgundy and wine...how could I resist the offer!?! ”

There we were, at the reserved corner table of a fine restaurant in Princeton tasting Savigny, Clos de Vougeot, Corton Charlemagne...what a tough job!

The wines were superb and the discussion was brilliant. Two of the wines were absolutely terrific: The Savigny-Les-Beaune “Aux Fourches” red and the lesser known Pernand Verglesses white; two wines coming from their own vineyards. The Savigny in particular was very surprising to me; pretty, deep color accentuated by a very bright but complex “pinot noir” nose, earthy but elegant with very soft and round tannins. The wine was getting better and better as we talked. A great wine, very well crafted with good depth, great balance, and generous clean red berries.

Maison Champy, founded in 1720, was a well respected house until the mid-1960s. Pierre Murgéy took it over in 1990, with the aim of resurrecting the historic domaine; the hiring of a talented winemaker, Dimitri Bazas, in 1999, pushed that goal to fruition. Both men share the philosophy of identity through determined, careful small production. Due to their artisan size, they concentrated their efforts on a few Villages-level wines (of which the Savigny and Pernand Verglesses are examples.) The style of vinification over the last several vintages has changed dramatically, with 2006 being perhaps the finest expression of their work.
